AR-DHS Program Recap



The CURES Act & What is EVV



EVV is a computer-based system that electronically documents and verifies service delivery information for certain Medicaid service visits. EVV helps prevent fraud, waste and abuse while making sure Medicaid recipients receive care that is authorized for them.

Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) is a federal requirement for Medicaid-funded **home health services that require an in-home visit.** Arkansas Department of Human Services (AR-DHS) oversees the implementation and operation of EVV in programs that provide certain home and community-based services.

Section 12006 of the 21st Century Cures Act is the law that requires all 50 states to implement EVV in Medicaid programs for personal care and home health services.

In Arkansas, for this project, EVV impacts certain services overseen or covered by:

- Home Health Providers (FFS)
- PASSE (Managed Care)

Open Model Solution



The Arkansas EVV Solution is an Open Model which means that providers can use their own approved EVV System and send their EVV-related data to the EVV Data Aggregator, or they can utilize the EVV System that the State will provide. Arkansas DHS calls these providers utilizing an EVV system other than the State provided systems as an "Alt EVV" provider.



All visits, either verified in the state-provided EVV System or through a provider's approved alternative EVV System, will be sent to the EVV Data Aggregator. If a provider chooses to use an Alt EVV System, they will still be required to provide all of the 6 CMS EVV Requirement Elements per Section 12006 of the CURES Act.

AR-DHS has identified certain services as required for EVV—these include services that are or related to personal care services and home health services. Providers of these services will be required to use EVV.

EVV Services

- T1021/TD: Home Health RN Visit
- T1021/TE: Home Health LPN Visit
- T1021: Home Health Aide Visit
- S9131: Home Health Physical Therapy by a Qualified Licensed Physical Therapist
- S9131/UB: Home Health Physical Therapy by a Qualified Physical Therapy Assistant

EVV Implementation Timeline Updates





Self-paced training for all agency staff is available now.

Onboarding

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- Provider agencies are expected to begin preparing for onboarding processes with Sandata and are encouraged to begin onboarding early to ensure they have ample time to set up their data in the Sandata system or make changes to their Alt EVV system.
- Onboarding started in January.

Program Go-Live

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- Go-Live is slated for March 31, 2025.
- Providers will be fully live in the Sandata EVV System or aligned with an Alt EVV vendor.
- March 31, 2025, is the soft-launch date for Home Health EVV. Claims submitted without EVV data will be paid until the MMIS cut-off date is set. Arkansas DHS anticipates the softlaunch will last 60 days, and providers will be given at least 30 days' notice before MMIS cut-off.

Next steps for Medicaid Enrollment

- All RNs, LPNs, Home Health Aides, Physical Therapists, and Physical Therapist Assistants must enroll with Arkansas Medicaid.
- Enrollment requires a unique email address.
- Enrollment should be completed as soon as possible.
- DMS is currently working to streamline the process of enrollment for Physical Therapists, and Physical Therapists Assistants to be consistent with enrollment for RNs, LPNs, and Home Health Aides.

* Note the streamlined enrollment process will only be applicable to Physical Therapists and Physical Therapist Assistants who only provide Home Health Services.

Rendering Provider



Is Rendering Provider required?

- It is not currently required to include the rendering provider on home health claims.
- It is considered a best practice and is recommended to include the rendering provider on home health claims, and it will be required in the future (projected for 2025).
- The following slides show where the rendering provider should be identified on claims depending on submission method

Alt-EVV Vendor Attestation Form Reminder



- Providers who have selected an Alt-EVV vendor must complete an <u>Attestation Form</u> and send to <u>arthirdpartyevv@dhs.Arkansas.gov</u>.
- Your vendor cannot begin testing until an Attestation Form is received and processed.
- To date, only six (6) Attestation Forms have been received, and forty (40) providers have registered as selecting an Alt-EVV system.

Policy Questions & Answers

1. Is there a "hard stop" regarding when an agency cannot provide Home Health services for a patient?

The go-live date for EVV is March 31, 2025. There will be, at a minimum, a 60-day period for agencies to transition to EVV and comply with requirements before potential impact to payment. There will not be a point at which agencies cannot provide Home Health services for a patient, but there will be a point—the EVV go-live date or, ideally, ahead of the go-live date—in which Home Health services must be provided using EVV.

2. What if I need more information?

3. If we previously completed an Attestation Form for PCS, do we need to complete a new one?

Yes, you will have to complete an Attestation Form for Home Health if you are using an Alt EVV Vendor. If your agency has submitted an attestation for Personal Care, you will still be required to submit an attestation for Home Health.

4. Is there any change to the provider's billing process?

There is no change to the billing process yet, but it will be a recommended best practice to include the rendering provider on your claims. Including the rendering provider will be required in the future. When claims are submitted, there will be a verification done for EVV visit data prior to payment. Claims that are submitted when EVV visit data is not captured will be denied.



Provider Registration



Recap: Provider Registration Portal Is Open

- The provider registration portal opened on January 15th.
- Providers should register if they have not done so.
 - Home Health (FFS) providers should register via the provider registration portal
 - PASSE (Managed Care) providers were auto-registered
- Providers should complete an attestation form and submit to AR-DHS.

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Provider Request for Access Groups and Account Linkage

What is an Access Group?

- Providers with multiple Medicaid IDs can request to link their accounts using an access group.
- This allows you to log in once and access all associated accounts.

What do I need to do prior to requesting an Access Group?

Complete your <u>self-registration</u>

How do I request an Access Group?

Training Questions & Answers

1. If we have 20 employees in our agency, does this mean each one of them will have to complete training, and will each one require individual login credentials?

Agency administrators are required to complete a self-paced course on Sandata Learn on system security. Agency office staff can register for virtual instructor-led training or self-paced courses in Sandata Learn. Caregivers, therapists, and similar employees will be trained on Sandata Mobile Connect and Telephone Visit Verification by agency trainers who have gone through Sandata's training. The Caregiver Library is available without logging in to Sandata On-Demand and is available 24/7.
