By law, all DHS employees are mandatory reporters.



Reporting abuse is easy and anonymous. If you have reasonable cause to suspect abuse is occurring, you are required by law to report it.

If you believe a child is being harmed in their environment, notify the hotline or call 911 for emergencies or if there is immediate danger.



How do l report abuse?







Gather information! The more details you have, the better chance your report will be investigated.

Call the hotline and make the report. Remember, you can remain anonymous.
