## **ACHIEVING A BETTER LIFE EXPERIENCE (ABLE)**

Fran Jansen and Chris Scott with the Arkansas State Treasurer's Office informed Council members about the Arkansas ABLE program. "This is the best kept secret in the Arkansas disability community," shared Jansen. "Arkansas ABLE is a savings and investment plan that makes it possible for people living with a disability to be able to save and invest and manage their money and use it for expenses related to living with the disability." Similar to 529 college saving plans, Arkansas ABLE plans have been around for about five years. As of November 2023, there were 936 such plans opened with an average account size of \$5,600. Money saved can be used to pay for qualified expenses. "That includes any expenses incurred as a result of living with the disability that is intended to make the quality of life better," says Jansen. ### WHO'S FLIGIBLE?

#### ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUALS ARE THOSE WHO:

- Have a physical or mental disability that is expected to last for at least a year or can be terminal
- OR
- Their disability is included on the Social Security Administration's list of compassionate allowances conditions
- AND
- Onset of their disability occurred before age 26\*

\*The ABLE Age Adjustment Act, which increases the age of onset from 26 years to 46 years, was adopted in December 2022. This new eligibility age will go into effect beginning in 2026. Arkansas ABLE intends to adopt this change through State Legislative approval.

### WORKERS WITH DISABILITIES PROGRAM

"The Workers with Disabilities program exists to be able to help people who would be eligible for SSI (Supplemental Security Income) to be able to work and not lose coverage. That is the purpose of Workers with Disabilities. There isn't an earned income limit or an asset limit for this category.
