Objective:

This webinar is intended to provide facilities with more information on process changes, the new vendor, and important dates to remember.

These changes to the submission process will begin June 26, 2025. The new vendor will begin completing Level II assessment on July 1, 2025.





PASRR Regulations

A Level II evaluation must be completed for all applicants who meet nursing facility (NF) level of care requirements, and who have been identified as having suspected mental illness (MI) and/or intellectual disability (ID) by the Level I preadmission screening process.

Level II evaluations must also be conducted on NF residents with Mental Illness and/or Intellectual Disability, or related condition, any time there is a significant change in condition.





PASRR Regulations

Pursuant to 42 CFR §483.102 (a), the PASRR process applies to all Medicaid-certified nursing facility (NF) applicants, regardless of the source of payment for the NF services, and regardless of the individual's or resident's known diagnoses.

A Level I screening must be completed before a resident can be admitted into a nursing facility.

If a current nursing facility resident experiences a significant change in his or her mental or physical condition, the individual is subject to a Resident Review evaluation.





PASRR Regulations

According to 42 CFR §483.112(c), states must ensure the Level II is complete within an annual average of 7-9 working days.

This means that there should only be 7-9 working days between the time that the Department of Human Services (DHS) Division of Provider Services and Quality Assurance (DPSQA) Office of Long-Term Care (OLTC) - Medical Needs receives the Level I DMS Form 787 PASRR, and the time that the final Level II determination letter is sent to the parties and facilities.

Important Process Changes

The process will remain unchanged for any Level I assessments that do not identify a positive result.

Level I assessments that do not identify a positive result are NOT required to be submitted to DHS; however, providers are required to maintain these assessments in their files, and they must be readily available for review during a survey.





Below outlines the new process applicable to a positive Level I assessment:

Step 1:

• Provider completes the Level I assessment. If positive, send it to DHS at: <u>medneeds.PASRR@dhs.arkansas.gov</u>.

* Do not send any Level I assessments to AFMC. Level I assessments will only be sent to <u>medneeds.PASRR@dhs.arkansas.gov</u> *





Below outlines the new process applicable to a positive Level I assessment:

Step 2:

- Positive Level I assessments will be reviewed by DHS.
- If DHS agrees that a Level II assessment is necessary, DHS will forward the Level I assessment to AFMC to complete.
- If during the review DHS does not agree that a Level II assessment is necessary, DHS will contact the provider, and no further action will be required.



Additional steps for the new process applicable to a positive Level I assessment:

Step 3:

AFMC will complete the Level II assessment.





Additional steps for the new process applicable to a positive Level I assessment:

Step 4:

- DHS will review the Level II assessment and make a determination for admission to a nursing facility.This determination will be communicated to AFMC.
- AFMC will then distribute the determination result to the client, facility, and the representative/guardian.

* The above determination ONLY applies to PASRR eligibility. Medical eligibility must be obtained from Division of Provider Services Quality & Assurance (DPSQA) Office of Long-Term Care (OLTC) Medical Needs. Financial eligibility must be obtained from the DHS Department of County Operations (DCO). *



Important Dates to remember about the Pre-Admission Screening Resident Review (PASRR) Level I – DMS Form 787

Wednesday 06/25/2025

The last day Emeritus Corporation, also known as Bock Associates, will accept PASRR assessments for review. After this date, providers will no longer submit their assessments directly to Bock Associates.

<u>Thursday</u> 06/26/2025

Providers will begin submitting their positive Level I PASRR screening assessments directly to DHS instead of Bock Associates. They should be submitted to: <u>medneeds.PASRR@</u> <u>dhs.arkansas.gov</u>

<u>Tuesday</u> 07/01/2025

The new PASRR vendor, AFMC, will begin conducting Level II PASRR assessments and residential reviews forwarded directly to them from DHS. Providers are NOT to send PASRR assessments directly to AFMC.



Wednesday 06/25/2025

The process will remain unchanged for any Level I assessments that do not identify a positive result.

Level I assessments that do not identify a positive result are NOT required to be submitted to DHS; however, providers are required to maintain these assessments in their files and must be readily available for review during a survey.





Thursday 06/26/2025

First day for all providers to begin submitting their positive Level I (DMS 787 form) screening assessments directly to DHS DPSQA OLTC Medical Needs at the <u>medneeds.pasrr@dhs.arkansas.gov</u> email address.

Negative DMS 787 forms do not have to be sent to DHS DPSQA OLTC Medical Needs

Bock will no longer be accepting any DMS 787 forms







First day for Arkansas Foundation for Medical Care (AFMC) to begin completing PASRR Level II evaluations.

All positive DMS 787 forms will be sent directly to OLTC Medical Needs at the <u>medneeds.pasrr@dhs.arkansas.gov</u> email address.

Negative DMS 787 forms do not have to be sent to DHS DPSQA OLTC Medical Needs.

No DMS 787 forms or DMS 780 forms will be sent directly to AFMC.



Working Together For a Smooth Transition

Both AFMC and Bock Associates will be working together with DHS to make this transition process as easy as possible for providers. This transition is the first step to streamlining both the financial and medical eligibility process.

More information on financial eligibility streamlining will be provided at a later date.
