Adoption is a major life event for families and affects them in many ways. While most adoptions are successful and endure, the Arkansas Department of Human Services Division of Children and Family Services (DCFS) is aware that adoptive families may experience challenges after an adoption is final and may need support.

This support is key to maintaining permanent, safe, stable, committed, and loving families for children. Parents may need information that will strengthen their families and enable them to handle the challenges of adoptive parenting. DCFS provides assistance for adoptive families facing challenges.
